

# BASIC SAFETY WITH CALCIUM OXIDE

WHEN WORKING WITH CALCIUM OXIDE, IT'S IMPORTANT TO TAKE SOME BASIC PRECAUTIONS TO IMPROVE YOUR SAFETY.

## 1. Protect Your Breathing

Wear a dust filter mask when handling calcium oxide.

## 2. Protect Your Eyes

Wear shielded glasses or goggles at all times. Contact between your eyes and calcium oxide is dangerous. In the event of contact, flush eyes with water immediately and seek medical assistance.

## 3. Protect Your Hands

Wear a strong pair of cloth or leather gloves and be mindful of wrist burn from excess perspiration. Use a protective cream for your wrists if necessary.

## 4. Protect Your Skin

When possible, wear long sleeve shirts and long pants to minimize contact with the calcium oxide and maximize safety.

## LIME: SAFETY CONSIDERATIONS

**Respiratory Protection** – Dust filter masks are recommended for personal comfort and/or protection.
